We are Salesians of Don Bosco, a religious congregation founded on 18 December 1859 by Saint John Bosco. We live in community and are consecrated to God through the three vows of poverty, chastity and obedience. Don Bosco, inspired by the goodness and zeal of Saint Francis de Sales, gave us the name "Salesians".
